Bancroft's Consultation and Training Department offers customized assistance to school districts, families, and other provider organizations, to help them provide highly effective services to children and adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities.

Our consultation and training services are highly effective, as evidenced by the successful:

- transition of many students from out-of-district placements to their home school district
- maintenance of numerous students within their home school district, who had previously been identified for out-of-district placement.

As a result, more children receive education in the least restrictive environment, and at reduced cost to the students' school districts.

Bancroft's role can range from establishing a classroom for children with autism, to developing behavioral and educational programs for individual students, to training employees in evaluation, teaching and treatment techniques.

We specialize in helping those with severe behavior issues, using the principles of applied behavior analysis (ABA) in the home, school, vocational site and community settings.

Our interdisciplinary staff includes board-certified behavior analysts, certified teachers, school psychologists and certified brain-injury specialists, as well as speech-language pathologists, occupational therapists, physical therapists, and social workers.
