Program Benefits

- Serves all children in an inclusive setting
- Offers both full or part time schedules
- Provides structured activities throughout the day
- Emphasizes functional communication skill-building
- Offers a higher ratio of staffing than typical daycare centers
- Provides access to consultation services for children who are behaviorally challenged

Bancroft's new inclusive daycare program in Haddon Heights, New Jersey was established in response to needs expressed by families of children with autism and developmental disabilities. While most day care centers are not set up to accommodate or serve children with autism spectrum disorders and developmental disabilities, this program has been designed to serve **all children**.

Families can now enroll all their children in one center confidently, knowing that Bancroft's specially trained staff members will provide structured activities designed to help each child learn and grow. These include art, music and periodic community outings.

The Bancroft Inclusive Daycare Program gives children the opportunity to establish social skills and friendships in a comfortable and supportive environment. In addition, a range of professionals are available on-site for consultations, including behavioral therapists, special-education professionals and a Teacher of the Deaf.

Bancroft has a long history of offering a wide range of state-of-the-art services to children and adults with autism, intellectual and developmental disabilities and other neurological challenges. As leaders in the field, Bancroft has a strong track record of success in helping those served live the most fulfilling lives possible in their communities.

Who should attend?

Infants and children up to seven years of age. Services are available for children who are typically and non-typically developing including those with autism spectrum disorders and developmental disabilities, including behavioral challenges.
