- Position Title:** Volunteer Recreation Assistant
- Program:** Pediatric & Adolescent Residential Services
- Basic Function:** Assist in providing care, supervision, and safety of persons served during recreational activities.
- Reports To:** Manager of Volunteer Services & Residential Supervisor
- Time Commitment:** 2 hours, 1/week
- Community Need:** To nurture the abilities of people with neurological challenges so they can live as independently as possible.

Position Responsibilities:

- Lend support to staff by actively participating in offering recreation and leisure opportunities to the persons we serve:
 - Fitness Walk (Tuesday/Thursday 4:00-5:00 p.m.)
 - Board Games (UNO, Bingo, Sorry, Candyland...) 1/month
 - Gym Nights (Sunday, 5:30-7:00 p.m.) Games, dance exercise, sports
 - Recreation Partner (Play games, video games, sports 1:1 with persons served)
 - Gardening (assisting persons served with planting/caring for a garden.)
 - Arts & Crafts (weekdays 4-6pm or weekends, in different group homes)
 - Music Fun (play music, involve kids in rhythm instruments, etc.)
- Assist staff in providing emotional support, acceptance, safety, advocacy, socialization and learning opportunities for persons served.
- Provide a role model for persons served.
- Demonstrate core values of Teamwork, Compassion, and Independence in the performance of job responsibilities.

Special Skills/Requirements: Patience. Enjoy spending time with children/youth. Willing to PLAY.
