Based on the principles of Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA), the Bancroft Preschool & Early Education Program incorporates academic, social and physical development with evidence-based behavioral, medical and emotional support – in a new, expanded location that enables Bancroft to provide its all-encompassing educational program to children with a greater variety of physical, behavioral and medical needs than ever before.

Program enhancements include:

- Larger space to allow for greater movement and activity, and accommodate students with more diverse physical and medical needs.
- Gross Motor Room with sensory equipment to foster students' skills and abilities, and provide a quiet, calming environment for students.
- An autism-friendly design with wide hallways, large classrooms and plentiful recreational space informed by the success of the Welsh Campus.
- Enhanced outdoor recreation with an adaptive playground to support structured activities and encourage exploration, play, and socialization.
- Expanded curriculum for in the areas of life skills, water safety, health and physical education and creative arts.

- Integrated clinical treatment by experienced and credentialed clinicians, including ABA, Occupational, Physical and Speech Therapy.
- Integration of technology and staff to empower student communication, engagement and participation.
- Expanded collaborative learning opportunities for parents, children, educators and the community.
- Peer-to-peer social skills and enhanced transitioning skills development, and a new transitional program for 11-year-old students who will graduate to The Bancroft School.
- Planned community outings and experiences to further develop social skills and enhance learning.
