Customized Student-Centered Education

Integrated classroom models provide teachers with essential resources to deliver on each child's IEP. Through a carefully choreographed mix of communication, behavioral, educational, and vocational programming, we help each student achieve the highest level of independence possible.

Integrated Clinical and Therapeutic Specialists

Our expert and experienced team acts as an integral part of every classroom learning environment.

Transition

Students begin to prepare for adult life beginning at age 14, when they are encouraged to work on academic, behavioral, and social skills in the classroom and participate in hands-on job exploration. Students can practice their skills on campus at the campus store and greenhouse and in the community through volunteer work and job skills development. Transition preparation becomes the primary focus of the school day upon a student turning 18.

As students progress from education entitlements to eligibility-based services at age 21, we help families navigate through the transition process to position each graduate to access adult services.

RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT

Through Bancroft's residential treatment programs, we commit to families that their child will receive the expert and individualized care they deserve.

Lindens Neurobehavioral Stabilization Program

The Lindens is a renowned intensive treatment program for youth facing severe and disruptive behaviors. Using Applied Behavior Analysis, we work to reduce the frequency, duration and intensity of problem behaviors. Located on the Welsh Campus in Mt. Laurel, New Jersey, the Lindens Program offers a secure yet home-like setting.

Campus Residential Treatment Program

Located on the Welsh Campus, children receive therapeutic support with daily living skills, socialization and integration with the school. Bancroft partners with educational and vocational outlets, community resources, and families to prepare children to thrive in more independent environments and transition into adulthood.

Community Residences

Our group homes are located in neighborhoods in southern New Jersey and provide children with a supported environment in which they work on daily living skills, receive allied therapies and engage in community activities. Children enjoy abundant opportunities for socialization through many community-based activities.

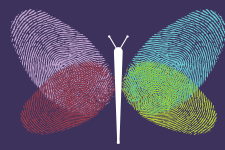

Severe Behavior Day Treatment Program

This unique program offers intensive outpatient treatment for children and young adults who are living with autism and experiencing severe and challenging behaviors that are interrupting their daily lives, impeding learning and preventing engagement in the community.

Supervised by doctoral-level clinicians, therapies are provided by licensed Board Certified Behavior Analysts (BCBAs) and Registered Behavior Technicians who together work with each child to reduce severe behaviors and help them return to school, community and family.
