Why an Evaluation Matters

At Bancroft, we go beyond test scores. We help families and providers understand how a child's brain and behavior connect.

An evaluation can be helpful when a child has:

- Medical or developmental conditions, such as seizures or premature birth
- Brain injury or other neurological event
- Ongoing struggles with attention, memory, or learning at school
- Behavioral or social challenges

Testing can help clarify:

- How a child learns best and which approaches may be most effective for school, therapy, and medical care
- Why certain behaviors may be happening and how to support positive change
- Which strengths to build on and which challenges to address
- Findings can support IEP or 504 decisions and classroom strategies

Types of Evaluations Available

Comprehensive Neuropsychological Evaluation

A full-picture view of a child's learning, behavior, and cognitive strengths and challenges to guide targeted support.

- **Includes:** Developmentally tailored testing across domains (attention, memory, language, executive functioning), a written report with clear interpretations and recommendations, and a feedback session to review findings.

Autism Evaluation

Determines whether a child meets criteria for Autism Spectrum Disorder.

- **Includes:** Standardized tools and rating scales, information about diagnosis, a written report, and a feedback session.

ADHD Evaluation

Evaluates whether attention-related behaviors meet criteria for ADHD to support educational and medical decision-making.

- **Includes:** Rating scales, cognitive and executive tasks as needed, information about diagnosis, a written report, and a feedback session.

Psychoeducational / Learning Evaluation

Identifies intellectual and academic strengths and challenges to guide accommodations and instructional strategies.

- **Includes:** IQ and academic testing, guidance on supports, a written report, and a feedback discussion.
