Collaborative IEP Development

Families, educators, and clinical team members work together with the school district to support each child's goals and guide meaningful progress.

Vocational Exploration Through Play

Children are introduced to early job and life skills in playful, age-appropriate ways to spark curiosity and prepare them for future learning.

Enrichment and Play

In a playful, inclusive environment, young learners explore through arts and crafts, music, movement, adaptive PE, and fun schoolwide events. Eligible students can also attend swim lessons at our Bancroft Welsh Campus.

Continuum of Care Connection

Children are supported in a playful, nurturing early learning environment, with the added reassurance of a broader Bancroft School Network that can continue to support them as they grow.

Family-Centered Support

Parents and guardians receive daily written communication, weekly phone calls, and monthly meetings. Training for family members is also available to ensure positive learning continues at home.
